“Birds of a Feather” (Primary: Kindergarten & Grades 1-3)

- ✓ Discusses different structures of a bird, including feathers, feet & beaks
- ✓ Children help to build the appropriate bird by choosing different structure
- ✓ Children learn how each bird is tailored to suit their environment and habitat that they live in including the things these birds need to survive

“Biodiversity” (Junior: Grades 4-6)

- ✓ Discusses the differences between nocturnal and diurnal animals
- ✓ Children learn how these animals' senses have adapted to each environment enabling them to survive

“Animals of the World” (Intermediate: Grades 7-8 / High School)

- ✓ Discusses various animals and how they have adapted to the different biomes of the world
